2010 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

For the 2010 NCHA Futurity, Non Pro Futurity, Derby, Non Pro Derby, Classic Challenge & Non Pro Classic Challenge

All rules of the National Cutting Horse Association Inc. (NCHA) not in direct conflict with the rules of the 2010 NCHA Futurity, as approved by the Board of Directors of the NCHA Inc. and as published herein will apply. These rules are subject to change by action of the NCHA Inc Board only. Judges selected will be named one month prior to the Futurity Show.

These events will be held in Tamworth from the 27th May to 6th June 2010.

I. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Owners and riders must be "Full" financial members of the NCHA Inc at the time of nomination.
2. The event is open to all horses irrespective of breed.
3. Recognition awards and ribbons will be presented to finalists.
4. Go Round ribbons will be given to four places in each round.
5. Proof of age to be supplied by official Registration or Recording Certificate issued by respective Breed Society or a notarized statement of age and description by a licensed veterinarian for unregistered horses including a photograph (as per the rule book 4A, page 46). A photocopy of your official Gold FOBIS certificate must be supplied for FOBIS registered horses. All papers to accompany nomination forms.
6. Proof of ownership must be supplied by the two parties concerned in the change of ownership if horse is not registered.
7. All Nominations will be inspected prior to the competition for verification of age by the official NCHA Equine dentist. A horse will not be eligible to compete if the age as determined by examination of its teeth exceeds the age as shown on the registration certificate or the notarised statement required for unregistered horses. Right of appeal will be by way of written application to the Executive Committee.
8. All nominations will be ineligible to compete until accurate identification is presented.
9. All entries and cattle hire must be paid before competing.
10. Prizemoney will be paid to the person whose signature appears on the entry form.
11. If sustaining or final payment is not made by due date, the nomination will be regarded as withdrawn and re-entry will only be accepted on payment of late fees (as per special condition 6).
12. There will be **NO REFUND/CARRY OVER OF ENTRY FEES.**
13. Entries must be named (**Excluding Non Pro Slots**) or described on nomination with the first payment, **due 01 October 2009.**
14. Change of ownership does not affect eligibility but the NCHA Inc must be notified of the transfer.
15. All nominations must be on the Official Entry form provided by the NCHA Inc and bear the signature of the owner or their agent.
16. Payments must be made on or before the due date. **THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THE CONDITION.**
17. The NCHA Inc reserves the right to cancel these competitions without liability and return all entry fees paid at any time should unforeseen circumstances occur.
18. Late fees will not be included in the payouts but will be used for added monies.
19. No horse will be allowed to start in the 2010 Futurity and Non Pro Futurity where it can be proven by the Board of Directors of the NCHA Inc that the horse has been shown or judged in an Affiliated or Unaffiliated cattle working event prior to the Futurity.
20. All payments include GST.
21. All payments must be on the official forms.
22. Payouts will be as per NCHA Rule Book and or Cadusch system.
23. Any violation of the rules will render the competitor ineligible to collect any prize money or trophy and should the same have already been awarded, must be returned to the NCHA Inc.
24. All scratchings must be in writing.

II. RULES APPLICABLE TO NON PRO ENTRIES

1. **A Non Pro has two options on entering the Non Pro Futurity, Non Pro Derby and Non Pro Classic Challenge divisions.**
 - a) You may name your horse when you send in the first payment.
 - b) You may enter your name (slot).
2. **A Non Professional may enter two horses or more in the Non Pro Division.**
3. **A Non Professionals rider's name (slot) may be sold to another Non Professional.**
 - a) A Non Pro may sell their slot or named entry after the draw but before the beginning of the first scheduled go-round. The buyer will be required to submit horses registration papers or a bill of sale showing proof of ownership to the NCHA along with \$250 (\$200 jackpot, \$50 Office charge). When a Non Professional sells a slot after the draw they cannot repurchase another slot in that class. They may however buy a horse from another Non Professional which is entered in that class and show the purchased horse in the slot which has been assigned to that horse.
 - b) If at the time of final nomination payment (**01 March 2010**) is made; the horse or horses to be ridden are not yet named, you have the option to withhold this information until 24hrs prior to the event for an additional charge of \$250.
 - c) Each Non Professional Futurity, Non Professional Derby and Non Professional Classic Challenge entry shall name the horse or horses to be ridden. If a Non Professional doesn't name their horse or horses before the draw, the working order will be drawn in the name of the rider; if two horses are entered, they shall work in alphabetical order. A rider that names one horse will work in the first assigned draw and the other draw will be left vacant.
4. **Double Entry and Transfer Privileges. Entry made in Non Professional rider's name (slot) may not be transferred to the Open Division.**
 - a) A Non Pro may transfer to the Open Division before the draw and only if the horse is named on the first payment entry form, and will be required to pay the difference between the open and non professional futurity entry fees plus \$500 plus \$100 transfer fee.
