

# **2010 NCHA Futurity Gate House Entry, Stable and Parking Procedures**

## **Stable, Camping & Parking Pre-Bookings**

All applicants for stabling, camping and parking must be pre-book by the specified dates through the NCHA office.

## **Gate House Entry**

On arrival to AELEC all vehicles will be directed to a designated "pre check in" area adjacent to the main stadium before they are allowed through the boom gates. Names will be checked off a spreadsheet and competitors will then be given their competitor packs. Staff at this pre check in point will also fit your wristbands and secure your parking stickers on your vehicles.

***There will be strictly no admittance through the boom gate area without having paid for your TRC seating levy, general admittance ticketing, stabling or camping etc.***

ALL VIP pass, marketing, sponsorship, media and event enquiries are to be directed to the NCHA Events office located at the front entrance of the AELEC stadium. As per last year, the NCHA show office will be located at the far end of the stadium near the bar area for all competitor show enquiries.

***Please note dogs and scooters are not permitted on the grounds of AELEC.***

### **Monday 24<sup>th</sup> May**

Gate House opens at 8am for arrivals and closes at 9pm

Security from the Stadium will open the gate for those already camping to re-enter after 9pm

### **Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> May**

Gate House opens 8am for arrivals and closes at 9pm

Security same as Monday

### **Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> May**

Same as Tuesday

### **Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> to Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> May**

Gate House opens at 6am and is attended on a 24 hour basis for the duration of the event

## **Stable Arrivals**

All stable allocations will be included in competitor packs which will be presented on arrival. Stables will be opened by a stable attendant upon notification from the boom gate operators. A stable plan will be located at the end of each stable barn for your convenience.

All competitors / handlers will be issued with organic waste management instructions as well as a newsletter which will be an introduction to site regulations and risk management standards.

All short term stable bookings in Barns A and B must be vacated by 8am Tuesday the 1<sup>st</sup> June.

Sale vendors can arrive from 5:30am on Wednesday 2nd June and must leave Saturday 6 June, unless prior arrangements have been made with the NCHA.

## **Competitor Car Park**

Asphalt car park spaces are reserved for camping vehicles only. All camping payments must be made prior to arrival. Any vehicle which pays for day parking spaces will be placed in the day parking area located in the paddock.

Arrivals will be ushered to their parking area by a parking attendant and directed to park in a bay which suits the size of the vehicle. Each vehicle will be allocated one bay only. If a vehicle is too long or wide to fit into the bay, the driver has the option to move to the paddock or can disconnect the prime mover and park it in the paddock. Hire caravans must provide an electrical certification from a licensed electrician prior to entering AELEC. These caravans will be located in a designated area.

Sale vendors may not arrive with horses prior to Wednesday 2nd June at 5:30 am unless prior arrangements with NCHA have been made. Sale horses must vacate their stables on Saturday 5th June unless prior arrangements have been made with the NCHA office.
