



# **RULES & REGULATIONS**

## **YARDS:**

Yards must be booked as there are only 48 yards available(first in best dressed).No stallions are to be placed in day yards please phone me if you need help with yards for colts. All yards will be locked so please find me and I will open them up for you, if you are arriving late please let me know and to make arrangements There are to be no shavings, straw or bedding to be used in the yards. All manure is to go in the bins provided.

Yards are only for competition horses, turnback horses and prework horses

## **MANURE:**

All manure is to be cleaned up and disposed of in bins provided. All yards must be cleaned out upon departure.

## **ENTRIES**

- Late Entries May be accepted with a \$20.00 surcharge per entry.
- All Entry Fees and Cattle Hire must be paid prior to competing in any contest.
- Notice of Intent to scratch a horse must be given in writing by the Tuesday prior to the commencement of the show otherwise cattle hire and entry fees will be payable
- Competitors Must Provide NCHA Numbers and be able to produce NCHA Membership Cards on the Day.
  - Rookie Cards must be held by Competitor.
  - All entrants compete at own risk.

## **ALL INCIDENTS MUST BE REPORTED**

Please see show management during show if incident occurs

## **COMPETITORS ONLY IN ARENA**

Only competitors and lopers may gain access to the arena, no owners or relatives

## **PARKING**

No parking zones will be marked with no parking zones

## **7 UP ENTRIES**

This event is for horses 7 years and older and all riders

Entry fee is\$158.70 for 2 go rounds, if you make the final cattle hire is to be paid.

1 – 14 entries: 2 complete go rounds, No final, pay sliding scale on aggregate

15 – 24 entries: 2 complete go rounds, top 8 to clean slate final, paying 8 places

25 – 50 entries: 2 complete go rounds, top 10 to clean slate final, pay 10 places
