iCompete SYSTEM**

2020 Darling Downs Futurity Show – Entries open via iCompete 16 Oct 2020

- Entries to be lodged on the NCHA iCompete system. ALL entries to be received by 5pm Friday 6 November 2020. If borders reopen late entries may be accepted from interstate competitors / owners without penalty – to be received by 12 November 2020 prior to scratching cutoff. Any entrant that is unable to gain a border pass will be refunded full entry fees without penalty but must notify the secretary prior to 12 November 2020 to be eligible for refund.
- ABSOLUTELY NO REFUNDS after 12 November 2020.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. FULL PAYMENT must be received by 6 November 2020 for inclusion in the draw.
2. Aged event entries will follow age specifications set by NCHA rules.
3. DDCC reserves the right to adjust prizemoney due to unforeseen circumstances.
4. DDCC reserves right to adjust start times and maintain control of all events including practice pens and mechanical cow work areas.
5. 15% of entry fees will be deducted for administrative purposes and NCHA levies.
6. All fees must be paid in FULL as per entry form – late entries if accepted will incur \$110 per nomination if not due to border restrictions.
7. **All** competitors **MUST** provide either a signed chq or a copy of credit / debit card and signed authority for deduction of any outstanding fees including practice pen, hay etc. **PRIOR** to the commencement of the show. Unpaid accounts, dishonored chqs / payment rejection, at close of show will incur \$110 per account unless prior arrangements are approved by show secretary.
8. Uncleaned stables will incur a \$44 fee per stable.
9. Finals cattle hire is an added cost to ALL FINALISTS and payable **prior** to competing in the final as per condition number 7
10. Prizemoney will be withheld until all outstanding monies are paid. Prizemoney will be paid to designated person/s on entries and payed via direct deposit.
11. All payouts are as per NCHA rules (inc Snaffle Bit)
12. DDCC conduct shows as per NCHA Rule Book – DDCC assume no responsibility for accidents to horses, handlers or any other person.
13. **TIMES UP** sponsored buckles to highest scoring amateur in non pro futurity, non pro derby, non pro classic challenge. Amateur Final will be conducted including the top 4 amateurs plus equals from each aged non pro event gaining an entry into a one herd final. Competitors **MUST** nominate via iCompete to be eligible
14. INTERSTATE competitors **MUST** provide a copy of their approved border pass to the secretary no later than 12 November 2020 to be included in the draws, if pass is not provided and arrangements have not been made to scratch your runs you will not be entitled to a refund.
15. ALL competitors, owners, trainers, workers, lopers, family members and visitors **MUST** comply with **DDCC COVID SAFETY** plan. Failure to comply will result in cancellation of entries with no refund and removal from grounds.
16. Electric fence areas must be paid **AT THE OFFICE PRIOR TO ERECTION AND MUST NOT be erected until a committee member has been consulted** at the ground and is approval is granted. Electric fence areas to be **inspected and approved** by a committee member. Anyone erecting an electric fence area without approval will be directed to remove the fence.
