



### Terms and conditions

1. Entries are through I-compete for NCHA events any problems contact the NCHA.
2. Committee reserves the right to alter the program at any time due to entry numbers, start time and/or cattle.
3. Late entries may not be accepted and if are will be accepted at discretion of show committee and shall be placed at the end of the first available heard and no extra cattle are required to be allocated for that entry.
4. Third party entries will NOT be accepted.
5. Scratching will be accepted up to 4 full days before the show date and must be emailed to [wgqhacutt@gmail.com](mailto:wgqhacutt@gmail.com) i.e. Monday before show weekend.
6. There will be 2.5 head of fresh cattle per run except Improver and Youth Improver will be rerun cattle. Preworks is 2 fresh cattle for 3 minutes.
7. **Any person riding a horse at an event must either be a current NCHA member or pay a NCHA day fee this includes all competitors, lopers and horse helpers.**
8. All Victorian Statutory Requirement must be adhered to.
9. Camping with powered site is first in best dressed with a fee of \$10 per night, ALL power leads need to be **kept off the ground** and be current test and tagged.
10. There is a 10pm noise and generator curfew.
11. Horse yards are first in best dressed, must be left clean & place chains back on horse yards after use.
12. There is to be no horse yards to be built in the middle grass Island on the grounds.
13. Clean up horse manure/feed and must be removed from the grounds.
14. There is to be no tying horses to trees on the grounds.
15. The show will conduct in accordance with the NCHA rule book. The committee assume no responsibility for accidents, to horses, handlers, and/or any other person.
16. To gain WGQHA high points you need to do a minimum 3 shows and be an approved finical member before any points are gained.
