## IMPORTANT NOTICE – FIRE ANTS

**It is crucial that we are all mindful of our responsibility and duty of care and comply with all directions to protect our community, particularly our agricultural industry.**

Fire ants are smart and highly adaptive and can survive in a range of climates and conditions. They can travel over and underground, fly up to 5 km and raft on waterways after floods or wet weather events. Fire ants can also spread when people move:

- materials such as soil, hay, mulch, manure, quarry products, turf and potted plants
- containers that have been used with organic materials, such potted plants
- dirty machinery that has been used to move restricted material.

Fire ant biosecurity zones apply to anyone who works with materials that can carry fire ants, sourced from inside the zones. The following local government authorities may be affected by these measures:

Additional information for event:

Practice pen will be in use for Futurity horses only, draw lists will be at the pen and each combination per round is crossed off once they have a go. This will be manned by volunteers so please be mindful and treat others respectfully when using this area. Anyone treating cattle disrespectfully as well will also be dealt with by Killarney Cutting Club committee staff, results may lead to being asked to leave grounds and nominations refunded. We will also have two mechanical flags available free, same again please use and NOT abuse our equipment.

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**All entries will be completed via ICompete website only. Entries will open 1/02/2024, and entries will close on 20/02/2024. Any Scratching's need to be completed via ICompete before 5pm on 25<sup>th</sup> Feb 2024.**

#### **Futurity (Open and Non-Pro) T & C's**

All Futurity events will be run under NCHA guidelines, with added money only to prizemoney as under conditions allowed by NCHA. Two judges to be used for all Futurity go rounds with 3 head per run allowed.

#### **Open Futurity** event will be structured as follows:

14 or less nominations will be a 2-round plus clean slate final for top 8 with placings highest to lowest, payouts to 8<sup>th</sup> place.

15-24 nominations will be 2 rounds with clean slate final for top 8, payouts to 8<sup>th</sup> place.

25-50 nominations will be 2 rounds with clean slate final for top 10, payouts to 10<sup>th</sup> place.

**Non-Pro Futurity** will be 2 rounds only and will be placed on aggregate scores, payouts to 6<sup>th</sup> place.

Riders are restricted to four horses plus one gelding.

Practice Pen- only to used for Futurity Horses, cost included in nominations, 1 practice per go round only.

Cattle Hire included in nominations, includes final for Open as well, no extra fee if you make the final.

Open and Non-Pro Futurity buckles supplied by Wild Horse Cutting Club and presented to winners.

Preworks are for horses competing at a 2024 Futurity event held after this points year concludes, eg. one-year younger horses than those competing at this futurity event.

Anyone riding a horse during this event must be an NCHA member or have NCHA day membership during this event.

Full payment made via ICompete to be made to be included in the draw.

Killarney Cutting Club reserves the right to amend start times/dates if numbers change.

Uncleaned stables will incur a large penalty fee of \$100 if not cleaned, this also includes taped areas for others. We plan to have designated areas for manure piles during this event, please dispose of all manure properly.

All payouts will be in accordance with NCHA rules.

Killarney Cutting Club will run this show under guidelines of NCHA rulebook.

Killarney Cutting Club is NOT responsible for any accidents to horses and people during this event.

All payouts will be paid via electronic banking, thus, please check your details are correct on the ICompete system.

All electric fence areas as above, must be constructed under consideration of many competitors fitting into a small area. Larger than required tape yards will be asked to be reduced by KCC committee members, to assist with all competitors in mind.  
All events will have 3 head of cattle per event except Grassroots with 2head.  
Snafflebit event may have to use 50% reuse cattle if numbers become short during the show.

**Rules / Eligibility for Grass Roots Events** 1. To be eligible to compete, a competitor must be a financial NCHA member or take out a day membership 2. First years NCHA membership may be purchased at half price, subsequent annual memberships will be full price 3. The competition will be split into two separate events – cutting and snafflebit which will be judged separately 4. To be eligible you must NOT have won 3 NCHA cutting events in any class NOR won \$500 or more in any NCHA cutting classes. If you win 3 events or exceed \$500 in winnings you may remain in the class until the end of the points year 5. A competitors run will consist of cutting two cows with two minutes working time per run. 6. The event will be judged under the same rules as all NCHA events 7. Dress code and all other NCHA rules and policies apply as per NCHA rule book 8. One horse one rider however a horse may be entered in both classes with the same or 2 separate riders 9. As per Rookies classes the rider does not have to own the horse 10. On payment of a second entry fee, at the time of initial entry submission, you may enter the same horse twice in the same event however only your highest score will count towards placings and points NCHA RULE BOOK - 2019 44 11. A 1A or above NCHA judge must be engaged to judge the event with the judge providing feedback after the completion of the event to the competitor, if requested, to assist in improvement 12. Points will be allocated as per NCHA rule book but for placings down to 10th place, limited to 1 point per 2 competitors (ie if there are 20 competitors in the class 1st place will receive 10 points down to 10th place receiving 1 point) all points will go towards point scores for end of year National buckles and if applicable individual club point scores. 13. Once a Grass Roots competitor achieves earnings of \$500 or they win 3 events they will be awarded an achievement badge 14. In the event that there is a tie for end of year point scores the following will be used to determine the winner – 1. Cumulative dollars earned 2. Total number of shows attended.

### **BEGINNER HORSE Unaffiliated**

A beginner horse is a horse that has not won any affiliated money with the NCHA in a hand down event or snaffle bit event (grass roots events not included). A horse will become ineligible to compete after winning 3 Beginner horse events or upon winning any money in an affiliated NCHA event excluding Grass Roots events. Pro trainers are eligible for this event at our shows.

### **One minute clock-**

As of 2/2/24, Killarney Cutting Club wish to advise all competitors that we will be using the one minute clock during the show and wish for all to adhere to this rule or be fined \$220 inc GST. Please see below from NCHA Rulebook  
Each horse is allotted two and one-half (2 ½) minutes to work during a run. The working time starts when the rider crosses the official timeline. As soon as the horse, owner and rider's name are called to the herd by the announcer (the "rider announcement"), the timekeeper will start the 1-2 ½ minute clock to let the rider know how much time the rider must cross the official time line and begin the rider's run. b) If the rider has helped the contestant immediately preceding the rider's run or has drawn back-to-back in the working order, the rider will have 2½ minutes from the rider announcement to cross the official timeline and start their run. c) If the rider has not helped the contestant immediately preceding the rider's run or has not drawn back-to-back in the working order, the rider will have 1 minute from the time of the rider announcement to cross the official timeline and start their run. d) If the rider fails to cross the official timeline in the time allotted under the 1-2 ½ minute clock, a buzzer will sound and on additional minute will be added to the 1 - 2 ½ minute clock. (This is the only warning that the rider will receive relating to the 1 - 2 ½ minute clock.) e) If the rider receives any additional buzzers relating to the 1-2½ minute clock at any time during the show, it will result in a \$200 fine per occurrence. (i.e. - second buzzer is \$200 fine, third buzzer is an additional \$200 fine, etc.) THIS WILL BE ENFORCED. (costs here are plus GST to equal above \$220 value)
