

THE PINNACLE TERMS & CONDITIONS

The Pinnacle is a high- profile event which will consist of two categories; an Open category and a Non Pro category.

OPEN CATEGORY

1. All competitors must be full financial NCHA members.
2. The Open Pinnacle will be a single herd, 15 horse OPEN event.
3. There will be 13 Slots available for purchase, from 9am to 5pm Wednesday 30th April, plus 2 available for Auction at the Open Futurity Calcutta on Wednesday 4th June. Allocation of the two slots to be Auctioned; one goes to Prize Pool, and one is retained by the NCHA to cover costs.
4. If more than 13 entries are received within the allotted time period, all received entries will be drawn at random in the NCHA office at 12 noon on Monday 5th May.
5. The cost of each Open Slot will be \$2550.00 (GST Inclusive)
6. \$2,000 from each of the 13 Slots available for purchase will go back to the prize pool giving the Open event a minimum prize pool of \$26,000.
7. Sponsorship of \$10,000 – granting total prize purse of \$36,000 plus The Pinnacle trophy and Buckle.
8. Prize money for the Open event will be paid out to the top five places as follows:
 - 1st \$13,500
 - 2nd \$10,500
 - 3rd \$6,500
 - 4th \$3,000
 - 5th \$2,500
9. Slots do not need to be named until 9am, the day of the event, at which time the draws will be completed.
10. The Slot owner is NOT required to own the horse competing in that slot.
11. Slot owners reserve the right to sell on their Slot at any price, any time prior to 9am the day of the event.
12. Rider only – One Ride/One Horse; exception- an extra ride for an Open rider must be purchased from the two auction slots.

NON PRO CATEGORY

1. All competitors must be full financial NCHA members.
2. The Non Pro Pinnacle will be a single herd, 15 horse Non Pro event.
3. All competitors must hold a current Non Pro Card.
4. There will be 15 Slots available for purchase, from 9am to 5pm Wednesday 30th April. If more than 15 entries are received within the allotted time period, all received entries will be drawn at random in the NCHA office at 12.30pm on Monday 5th May.
5. The cost of each Non Pro Slot will be \$1,725.00 (GST Inclusive)
6. \$1,250 from each of the 15 Slots available for purchase will go back to the prize pool giving the Non Pro event a maximum prize pool of \$18,750.
7. Sponsorship of \$6,250 – granting a total prize purse of \$25,000.00 plus NP Pinnacle trophy and Buckle.
8. Prizemoney for the Non Pro event will be paid out to the top five places as follows:
 - 1st \$9,750
 - 2nd \$7,250
 - 3rd \$4,500
 - 4th \$2,000
 - 5th \$1,500
9. Slots do not need to be named until 9am, the day of the event, at which time the draws will be completed.
10. The Slot owner is NOT required to own the horse competing in that Slot, however, Non Pro rules apply to the horse and rider combination.
11. Slot owners reserve the right to sell their Slot at any price, any time prior to 9am the day of the event.
