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Middlemount Cutting CONDITIONS OF ENTRY CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

BY ENTERING THIS SHOW, YOU AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Rocky Cutting Club conducts shows as per NCHA Rule Book
- 2. FULL PAYMENT must be received for inclusion in the draw.
- 3. Entries AND PAYMENT will be accepted via icompete. Payment is to include camping / stabling / tape yards etc
- 4. The program is subject to change due to entry numbers and Rocky Cutting Club reserves right to adjust start times and maintain control of all events including practice pens and mechanical cow work areas.
- 5. Scratchings will be fully refunded prior to 28/7/25 before 8pm. Refunds WILL NOT apply if you scratch after this time and date. Scratching cutoff is 28/7/25 no refunds will be at 8pm issued or alterations will be made after this time.
- 6. If the show is cancelled prior to its commencement due to extreme weather conditions or other circumstances, your entry fees will be fully refunded less any costs incurred by the club eg if cattle have already been delivered.
- 7. Cancellation of the show at the commencement or during the show due to extreme weather conditions or other circumstances, your entry fees will be refunded less cattle hire (only if cattle have been delivered and paid for) and 50% of the office fee.
- Prizemoney will be paid to designated person/s on entries and paid via direct deposit at the conclusion of the show into your nominated account in icompete please ensure these details are correct and gst status in icompete is correct. This can also be done when renewing your membership.
- 9. All payouts will be in accordance with NCHA Rules.
- 10. Rocky Cutting Club assume no responsibility for accidents to horses, handlers, or any other person.
- 11. The One Minute clock will be used at this show

Each horse is allotted two and one-half $(2\frac{1}{2})$ minutes to work during a run. The working time starts when the rider crosses the official timeline.

a) As soon as the horse, owner and rider's name are called to the herd by the announcer (the "rider announcement" – including the first horse of the herd), the timekeeper will

start the $1-2\frac{1}{2}$ minute clock to let the rider know how much time the rider must cross the official timeline and begin the rider's run.

b) If the rider has helped the contestant immediately preceding the rider's run or has drawn back to-back in the working order, the rider will have 2 ½ minutes from the rider announcement to cross the official timeline and start their run.

c) If the rider has not helped the contestant immediately preceding the rider's run or has not drawn back-to-back in the working order, the rider will have 1 minute from the time of the rider announcement to cross the official timeline and start their run.

d) If the rider fails to cross the official timeline in the time allotted under the 1-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ minute clock, a buzzer will sound and on additional minute will be added to the 1- 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ minute clock. (This is the only warning that the rider will receive relating to the 1- 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ minute clock.)

e) If the rider receives any additional buzzers relating to the 1-2 ½ minute clock at any time during the show, it will result in a \$200 fine per occurrence. (i.e.- second buzzer is \$200 fine, third buzzer is an additional \$200 fine, etc.) THIS WILL BE ENFORCED.

12. ALL competitors, trainers, workers, lopers, horse handlers etc must hold current NCHA membership or purchase a show membership prior to handling / mounting a horse

- 13. There are a number of powered campsites available, it may be necessary for competitors to provide their own generators.
- 14. Electric fence areas are the responsibility of horse owners and trainers and they must ensure the safety of horses and people, they may be inspected by a committee member and if deemed unsafe competitors may be directed to remove the fence.
- 15. **NO** sleeping on the ground ie all campers must be in a horse float, gooseneck, caravan etc for insurance purposes
- 16. Manure and rubbish must be removed and dumped in designated areas. Uncleaned camp and tape yard areas will incur a **\$50** fee per site at the conclusion of the show.
